PANPSYCHISM. In philosophy, panpsychism is the view that mind or consciousness is a fundamental feature of the physical reality; it is the doctrine that everything material has an element of consciousness. Panpsychism unites mentality and consciousness with the physical world as it offers an attractive middle way between physicalism on the one hand and dualism on the other; it promises a unified concept of nature.* "Modern panpsychism proposes that consciousness is intrinsic to all forms of information processing and stands alongside forces such as gravity, electromagnetism and the strong and weak nuclear forces." ** Panpsychism is one of the oldest philosophical theories, and has been ascribed to philosophers like Thales, Plato, Spinoza, Leibniz and can be seen in ancient philosophies like Stoicism, Taoism and Vedanta.
